JANUARY 15, 2010

Early this morning we will depart from Woodstock to Detroit airport where a North West direct flight will take us to Ft. Lauderdale (valid Canadian Passport is required). On arrival in Ft. Lauderdale we will transfer to the lovely **Sheraton Suites Hotel**. You will be impressed with the large suite rooms and Sheraton Sweet Sleeper Beds. Enjoy the beautiful pool and relax this evening. For the 'Snowbirds' you can drive over to Ft. Lauderdale and stay the evening with the rest of the passengers and we have included parking for your car while away on the cruise.

JANUARY 16, 2010

Breakfast is included this morning and then we'll depart at 11am this morning for the **Port of Ft. Lauderdale**.
