NOVEMBER 18, 2008 If you love Christmas and Country Music this tour is definitely for you! Inquire about our motor coach pick up points when you call the office. Today we travel to Sharonville Ohio where we will overnight. We invite you to a cocktail reception from 5:30–7pm where you will be given three drink coupons per person. Fifteen minutes of free long distance to Canada is complimentary per room. The hotel is adjacent to the Cracker Barrel and Ruby Tuesday Restaurants so we will be providing you with a \$15.00 per person voucher that you can use at your leisure at either restaurant this evening. NOVEMBER 19, 2008 Scrambled eggs, sausage, biscuits and gravy, freshly-made Belgium Waffles or pancakes are just a few of the treats on this mornings breakfast buffet. Today we travel to our overnight stop – Lexington, Kentucky. This afternoon we will be met by a local expert who will take us on beautiful tour of the area including a visit to a famous horse farm.
